Passport to Prom

Today we have launched 'Passport to Prom' for all our Year 11 students. We wanted to take this opportunity to share what this includes and the criteria that students must meet to be eligible to attend our prom. As you will be aware the prom is a huge celebration and it signals the end of 11 years of compulsory education for all students. At The Wells Academy, we want to go above and beyond to celebrate this with students.

We have spent considerable time this year reminding students of the importance of effort and the relationship it has with success and reward. This theme has continued with our launch of 'Passport to Prom'.

On Monday of each week, students will be able to see a copy of their Passport to Prom balance sheet on display within the Year 11 area. We will communicate with you on a regular basis so that you are able to talk to your child to support, praise and encourage them and increase the likelihood of them securing eligibility.
